

Court Affirms Order Requiring Partition of Property Where Fiduciary's Homestead Argument Failed

In *Byrom v. Penn*, Byrom was appointed executor of his mother's estate, and he was later removed as executor for breach of fiduciary duty by using estate funds to build a house for himself.
