

Court Holds That Insurers Do Not Generally Owe Fiduciary Duties To Insureds

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In *Ec & Sm Guerra v. Phila. Indem. Ins. Co.*, an insured sued its property insurer for breach of fiduciary duty and other claims arising from the insurer's denying a claim for wind damage and disagreeing with an appraiser's report.
