

## Are Punitive Damages Insurable in Texas? High Court: Definitely Maybe, Insurance Journal

In *Fairfield Insurance Co. v. Stephens Martin Paving, LP*, the Texas Supreme Court addressed, for the first time, whether punitive damages were insurable in Texas. No. 04-0728, 2008 Tex. The certified question was whether Texas public policy prohibits a liability insurer from paying a punitive damages award imposed on its insured because of gross negligence.
